

Troop 339 Camping Trip Personal Gear List

This is a general gear list for a typical weekend camping trip. It is suggested that rain gear and flashlight be carried with the Scout on the trip to camp and not packed away. Personal gear is the last gear to be unloaded off the trailer

Electronic Games, Radios, CD Players, etc. are NOT allowed on Troop 339 Camping Trips. Cell phones are highly discouraged, and may be confiscated by Adult Leadership. Adult Leaders always have cell phones for emergency use.

Item

Scout Uniform

Notes

Class "A" uniform is always worn traveling to and from camp, unless specifically told otherwise

Duffle Bag or Sports Bag, or Backpack for Gear

Frame Packs are not allowed in Troop Tents. Soft bags only

Outdoor Essentials

Water Bottle – Filled

1 Liter enough for most trips, more required for Backpacking trips

Flashlight

Bring in car for trip to camp, most trips we arrive at night

Rain Gear

Jacket and pants preferred, poncho acceptable

Pocket Knife

Totin Chip required

Rope

10-20 Ft. Small rope or sturdy cord

Small roll toilet Paper

Personal First Aid Kit

For Minor injuries only, troop carries a complete emergency first aid kit

Clothing

All clothing is weather appropriate and will vary for each trip. Always plan to dress in layers so that clothing becomes more versatile as weather conditions change. Be Prepared.

Shirts and Pants or Shorts

T-Shirts and underwear – 2 Pair

Jacket, sweater, fleece

Socks

Dependent on conditions

At least 3 pair, wool cold weather – cotton warm weather

Sturdy hiking shoes or Boots

Extra shoes

Pajamas, sweats

For around camp wear

For sleep wear, you must have something clean and dry for sleeping especially when cold

Hat

Wool or fleece cap for cold weather, baseball cap or other wide brim hat other times

Sleeping Bag

May need to supplement with blankets when cold

Sleeping Pad

Foam pad to insulate from the cold ground

Pillow

Optional

Eating and Cleanliness

Knife, fork, and spoon

Lexan works best

Bowl and plate

Plastic doesn't get hot, works best

Cup

Suitable for Cold and Hot drinks

Soap

Campsuds is biodegradeable and goes a long way

Small towel and washcloth

Toothbrush, toothpaste, floss

Personal Extras

Medications

All personal medications are to be given to the Adult Responsible for medications for the trip

Camera

Optional, recommend disposable cameras

Scout Handbook

Keep in Ziploc Bag to keep clean and dry

Watch

Small bottle of sunscreen

Especially if you are prone to sunburn

Sunglasses
